

Index of Social Health

1. Poverty Rate:
 - a. 2004 Percent of “working poor” Households (employed, with income less than 200% poverty level: 16%
 - b. 2001 Percent of “working poor” Households (employed, with income less than 200% poverty level: 15%

2. Unemployment rate
 - a. 2004 Percent not working, looking for work: 5%
 - b. 2001 Percent not working, looking for work: 3%

3. Violent crime rate:
 - a. 6.8 per 1000 people
 - b. 1999 rate: 6.0 per 100,000 people

4. Low birth weight:
 - a. 2003 Percentage: 11.3%
 - b. 1999 Percentage: 6.5%

5. Infant mortality rate
 - a. 2003: 5.1 per 1000 in = .0051%
 - b. 1999: 4.5 per 1000 in = .0045%

6. Premature mortality rate
 - a. 2002: 329.79 per 100,000=.0033%
 - b. 2001: 274.68 per 100,000=.0027%
